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TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Contestants may enter up to three events (one singles, one doubles, and one mixed doubles).
2. Players within the circulation area of the Times Herald are eligible to compete. The decision of the Robinson Tournament Committee with regard to player eligibility will be final.
3. Eligibility Guidelines:

Junior Divisions: Junior players may play an age division until the month in which you age up, or, in other words, until your birthday month. This means that players that are **12, 14, 16** or **18** years old may continue to play in their 12, 14, 16 or 18 age division until the month in which they turn **13, 15, 17** or **19**, respectively. For example: A player who is 14 on the day the tournament starts may play in the 14- and-under age division. The starting date of a tournament determines the player's eligibility for that tournament.

Adult Divisions: Players who will reach the age of **35, 45, 55, or 65** by **12-31-09** will be eligible to compete in their respective age division.

OPEN Division: Any player, regardless of age or sex is eligible for the Open Division.

WOMEN'S OPEN Division: Any female player, regardless of age is eligible for the Women's Open Division.
4. A minimum of six entrants/teams per event is required. Events may be combined where necessary.
5. Weather permitting, a Consolation Back-Draw for first round non-winners may be held for junior singles events.
6. Time permitting, players will be allowed 20-30 minutes in between matches
7. The "Roving Umpire" and "Point Penalty" systems will be in effect throughout the tournament. Umpires have the authority to call foot faults, settle disputes and assess penalty points, if necessary, for improper behavior. Also, contestants not reporting at scheduled check-in times may be defaulted.
